

WIMMERA MALLEE PIPELINE

With 85% of the region's precious water being wasted through seepage and evaporation, the efficiency of the Wimmera Mallee open channel water system was under scrutiny. A significant water resource management project, this pipeline would essentially supply stock and domestic water to over 36 towns.
